There has been a drop in our attendance figures across the school and it is of some concern. For this reason, it is imperative that parents/carers contact the school office **before 9:05**, when registers close, to notify them of pupil absences. As you will appreciate, this needs to be systematically completed so as to not make errors. National average attendance is 95.8%. Ours dropped to 94.78%, and although it looks like a small drop it has an impact and is monitored closely externally. Thank you for your support on this matter.
