



<p>This term, we are studying Humans and other Animals in Science. As part of it we will be studying evolution. Could you in true Horrible Histories fashion, pretend to be Charles Darwin and explain your theory of evolution? <p>French: In French, we have been studying how to have a simple conversation, talking about our pets, birthdays, our date of birth/birthday and our likes and dislikes. We have also looked at instructions that we use in the classroom. Could you take some of the vocabulary on the Powerpoint, that I have put on Dojo and use this to create your own French vocabulary posters or flashcards to look at key words, sentences or phrases that we have been using. I will be looking for some to include on our French display.</p> <p>DT: I will include a challenge here that will last for the term. Could you create a model in a box, based on our Geography for next half term of Energy and sustainability. Could the model have different zones that show how we can be environmentally friendly in different aspects of life. For example, you might want to include a household zone, that shows houses recycling and a building with solar panels on the roof. Maybe you could have a farming zone, that uses wind turbines, solar panels and electric tractors. This task will be on the next home learning as well as I would love some spectacular models.</p>	<p>Art: We will be studying architecture and the impact of people on the environment. As part of this we will look at how buildings and plants can work together. Can you design a house that has plants at its heart.
